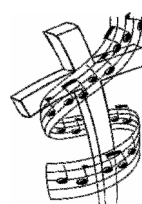

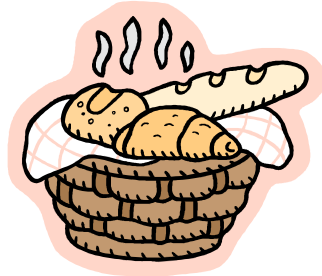
**Building Renovation Update!**
